**In Memory of Jasper Howard (1989-2009)**

Saturday October 17th of UCONN Huskies football team won big, 38-25, over Louisville. The results were an entire campus engulfed in excitement and joy, however, the mood changed very shortly after. In the early hours of Sunday October 18, 2009 UCONN football player Jasper Howard was fatally stabbed to death. The stabbing occurred after an altercation outside the student union.

He was only the age of 20 and on his way to greater things with his great skills in-

football. Not only did he leave so abruptly he also left behind a family and a girlfriend that was three months pregnant with his child. And as of October 27 there have been two suspects that have been arrested and will be due in court in the near future. Also there has been a third suspect arrested and will appear in court but no information has been released on his involvement to the crime. The three suspects do not attend the University of Connecticut.

Jasper was originally from Miami but came to UCONN to play football. Those who knew him on-

campus say he was a very outgoing and cheerful person. He aspired to play football professionally, not for his own personal fame, but to help his family financially.

Jasper Howard will certainly be remembered for all that he has done as a member of the UCONN football team and student body in general thereby we keep his memory close to our hearts. And further detail of the investigation will be provided in the near future.
